



## **Publisher (also known as “Content Server”)** **(applicable to AquaLogic Interaction 6.0 or Plumtree 5.0 audiences)**

### **Description**

The Publisher product, also known as Content Server, allows non-programmers to quickly create content generating portlets. These portlets allow end users to add content in the portal. This course identifies common business processes associated with managing published content and who is involved in these processes. Students learn how to create Publisher portlets, manage workflow, approve and publish new content, and edit the templates that control how content is both captured and presented in the portal. The course provides task-based scenarios, enabling students to get ample hands-on experience with their upcoming content related tasks.
